## PROFILE

Hon. Alfred Okoe Vanderpuije, a native of Otublohum in the Ga Traditional area of James Town, Accra, was born on November 4, 1955. He is a father of two daughters, Mildred and Alfreda Vanderpuije. Okoe, as he is affectionately called is an all-rounder, well-educated individual with several years of career record as an Educationist, a Youth Development Advocate and a Mentor.

In April 2009 and June 2013, President John Evans Atta Mills and H.E. John Dramani Mahama respectively nominated Hon. Vanderpuije to serve as Chief Executive of the Accra Metropolitan Assembly (AMA).

These nominations, put before the AMA, resulted in Hon. Vanderpuije receiving overwhelming support of 97.6% by 95 Honorable Assembly Members and 96.5% by 127 Honorable Assembly Members respectively to be appointed as Mayor of Accra, a position he has held since 2009.

## SOME ACHIEVEMENTS

- The Elimination of the "Shift System" of Education in Accra.
- Construction of over 122 Millennium City Schools out of which nineteen (19) have been completed.
- Introduction of the Polluter-Pay-Principle in solid waste management

- Provided a 1,500 liter Capacity Mechanized Community Borehole to benefit over 32,794 people within the Sempe-Korle-Gonno Community.
- Over 75km of community roads and drains including Asphalt overlays have been completed and others are on-going.
- Over four thousand streets in Accra have been named or renamed, digitized and street signage mounted.
- Introduced the "Operation Don't Cross the red line" which created adequate space for easy pedestrian movement on pavements in the City Centre.
- Has facilitated the approval of over 1,930 development permits for development projects to change the skyline of the City of Accra since 2009.

- Has initiated the development of about 12 PPP projects including Markets, Accra Conference Center and the City Corner of AMA
- Established sanitation and motor courts within the City
- Facilitated the distribution of Outboard Motors and Pre-mix fuel to fishermen.

- National Award, 2015 (Support for Sustainability of Homogenous festival of GA Adangbe)

- Mayor Vanderpuije was elected as President of the Global Alliance of Mayors and Leaders from Africa and of African Descent on 21st September, 2014.
- He was awarded as the best Mayor in Africa by Jose dos Santos Africa Mayor Award on 28th April, 2015.
- Mayor Vanderpuije was privileged to be part of selected Mayors of the World invited to the Vatican, Rome by Pope Francis on 22nd -23rd July, 2015.
- Millennium Excellence Awards, 2015 for Development, Sustainability and Accountability
- Accra was selected as one of Rockefeller Foundation 100 Resilient Cities on 7th April, 2015.
- Accra was also selected for the Bloomberg Initiative for Global Road Safety on 12th February, 2015.

Mayor Vanderpuije strongly believes in the adage "Service to Man is Service to God". Mayor Vanderpuije with a sense of commitment for excellence and a devotion to duty continues to serve the City of Accra. Currently, Alfred Vanderpuije popularly referred to as Tsentse, promises to represent the people of Ablekuma South effectively in Parliament and ensure the creation of opportunities for the youth and community development for the area.
